Proper clothing
is an important factor in creating
timeless portraits for you!

Keep it Simple - Color coordinate the outfit from head to toe. Consider the colors you use in your home. As a rule, put light colors together, or put dark colors together; pastels can be used alone or with light colors. If you are unsure, bring 2 or 3 outfits and we'll help you select what photographs best. The more complex the outfit, the harder it is to keep it straight and wrinkle free during the session. Select colors that go well in the room and with the other portraits in the display.

Patterns are fine if they are very subdued - A strong pattern competes with your child for attention. Avoid bold stripes, plaids, big emblems or designs, unless they have family significance. Children are one of a kind. Remember, your portraits become timeless heirlooms.

Shoes are optional - Don't spend a great deal of time searching for the perfect shoes. In many portraits, bare feet or socks work well. Simply put, cute little toes are better than the bottoms of shoes.
